Unless our valued parents shoulder this joint responsibility with the school, we cannot expect our students to pass out with good grades/marks in the BOARD EXAM which is a stepping stone for their future success. Let us act now and not wait for surprises. COVID-19 will go but one academic year lost, can never be re-gained.

- Constant support and **supervision from parents** will play a decisive role during these challenging times.
