SUB : PROMOTION POLICY FOR GRADE IX & XI

Reference to the guidelines under CBSE Promotion Policy, kindly note the following:

✓ **PROMOTION POLICY – GRADE IX TO X**

In order to be declared PASS:

- A student must secure 33% in total in Annual Exam and Internal Assessment to be promoted to Grade X.
- **Compartmental Examination :**
 - A student failed in maximum of two subjects only will be considered for compartmental exam.
 - If the child fails in compartmental examination or in more than 2 subjects, he/she will be detained in grade IX.

✓ **PROMOTION POLICY – GRADE XI TO XII**

In order to be declared PASS:

- A student must secure 33% marks in each of the subject studied by him /her.
- He/She must secure 33% marks **separately** in theory and practical portion. **If the child scores 33% in practical and less than 33% in theory (or VICE VERSA), he/she is declared fail in the given subject.**
- **Compartmental Examination :**
 - A student **failed in one subject only** will be considered for compartmental exam.
 - For practical subjects, the rule is generally interpreted as follows (as per CBSE norms) –
 - (i) If a student has failed in theory, compartment is given in theory only.
 - (ii) If a student has **failed/absented himself** in practical, he/she has to appear **both in theory and practical.**
 - If the child **fails in compartmental examination or in more than 1 subject, he/she will be detained in grade XI.**

As per directives, no marks will be awarded to students who fail to attend in school (physical) practical examinations (as per CBSE directives, Refer Notification No. CBSE/COORD/2021) and will be detained in grade XI. YIS is compelled to abide to this rule, unless there is any amendment in CBSE guidelines/ MOE directives.
