The Syllabus for CSEET comprises of an Online Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test (CSEET) consisting of Four (4) parts, Seven (7) Papers at Executive Programme and Seven (7) Papers at Professional Programme including Two Papers as elective papers. The Syllabus of Company Secretary Executive Entrance Test (CSEET) comprises of four parts: Business Communication, Legal Aptitude with Logical Reasoning and Quantitative Aptitude, Economic and Business Environment and Current Affairs.
